- 3. The first of the twelve factors of Conditioned Genesis is ignorance. What is this ignorance as described by the Buddha? How is it overcome through meditation?
- 4. Rahula distinguishes two forms of meditation. Discuss their functions briefly. In your own opinion, how could they operate to compliment each other?
